Here are the **abbreviations** and **symbols** that I use **to check writing compositions**, along with what the abbreviations stand for and their explanations:

CONT	This means you used the wrong conjunction .
CONJ	E.g. <u>Like</u> I said before CONJ
GR	This mistake relates to grammatical rules . E.g. She <u>don't</u> like butter. GR
PREP	This shortening stands for "preposition" and you should have used another one. E.g. We explored around the area <u>for</u> car. PREP
PUNC	This stands for "punctuation" and it means either the punctuation mark is missing or wrong. E.g. I like going riding horse? PUNC
SP	It means you made a spelling mistake. E.g. They felt <u>embarrased</u> about what they had done. SP
VT	This stands for "verb tense" , and it may mean that you used present instead of past, or present instead of "going to", etc. E.g. I go to church with Lucy last Sunday. VT
wo	It stands for "word order", so you should have reversed the position of the sentence components. E.g. My <u>Teddy bear cute</u> travelled in the back <u>three times more</u> WO WO
ww	By this we mean "wrong word" . E.g. The <u>macets</u> are on the balcony. WW
	This symbol means that word should be ruled out . E.g. Doris she purchased an amazing duplex in Boston.
/	This means a word is missing in that gap. E.g. I don't know what / do.
?	This means the word or passage is unintelligible or nonsensical. E.g. Max went for below in a beach an go the first ?
·!	This is a rewarding punctuation mark which means "well done!". E.g. I would appreciate it if you could be so kind as to give me a lift. !
